HB 1227 / SB 5300 CORONER SUBPOENA AUTHORITY

Coroners have subpoena authority only when a formal special inquest jury is called. These are very uncommon and costly. The lack of subpoena power in most of their death investigations unnecessarily delays determining a cause of death and awarding of benefits to the surviving family members.

WACO, County Coroners, and County
Prosecutors propose providing
Coroners subpoena power to assist in
all death investigations and notification
of next of kin.

A court-authorized subpoena serves the surviving family and assures a more efficient, timely and cost effective death investigation.
