## 1) Call to Order, Roll Call, Approval of Minutes

<u>Stacie Prada, President</u> called the meeting to order at 8:14 am. <u>Greg Zempel, Immediate Past-President</u>; <u>Rob Snaza, Sheriffs Trustee</u>; and <u>Eddie Cantu, Trustee at Large Position 1</u> were noted as absent.

Melissa Benton, Clerks Trustee MOVED to approve the September 27, 2022 agenda Ruth Gordon, Trustee at Large Position 5 SECONDED. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

<u>Jeff Gadman, Vice-President</u> **MOVED** to approve the July 20, 2022 Board of Trustees meeting minutes. <u>Breda Chilton, Trustee at Large Position 3</u> **SECONDED**. The **MOTION CARRIED** unanimously.

### 2) New Business

- a. Honoring Departing WACO Board Members, Welcoming New Member President Prada presented service awards to departing members Jerry Pettit, Past-President; Milene Henley, Auditors Trustee; Josie Koelzer, Treasurers Trustee; Trustee at Large Chilton; Trustee at Large Cantu; and Trustee at Large Gordon. President Prada introduced Leslie Valz, Treasurers Trustee.
- b. 2023 WACO Priority Legislative Proposals/Affiliate Priority Proposals Steve Drew, Thurston County Assessor provided the Assessors' legislative update. The Assessors' have no priority legislation proposal. Discussed potential legislative concerns including wind and solar PILT, large personal property tax exemptions, changes to the senior exemption program. Discussed the tax fairness workgroup and homestead exemption. Discussed tax id'ing primary residence and positive impacts on elections and licensing.

<u>Lori Larsen, Stevens County Auditor</u> presented the Auditors legislative priorities. Discussed a voter pamphlets standards bill which the Secretary of State supports. Discussed concerns about threats against elections officials.

<u>Lisa Henderson</u>, <u>Trustee at Large Position 6</u> presented the Clerks' legislative priorities. Discussed dependency publication. Met with AG Office regarding the issue and will continue a dialog. Discussed the removal of the overpayment refund threshold in 2022. Discussed a bill fix for the overpayment issue which the 2022 bill sponsor supports as it may have been an oversight.

<u>Hayley Thompson, Skagit County Coroner</u> presented the Coroners' legislative priorities. discussed the ongoing forensic pathologist shortage. Sen. Dhingra has agreed to sponsor a study/marketing funding bill. Discussed addressing WSP State Toxicology Lab backlog. Data received – provided important information to a potential sponsor.

<u>Jon Tunheim, Prosecutors Trustee</u> Discussed areas of focus for WAPA related to the criminal sentencing task force in lieu of a policy proposal.

<u>Timothy Grisham, Deputy Director</u> shared that the Sheriffs have no priority bill. Issues they are following are: Blake/Simple Possession, vehicular pursuits, addressing juvenile attorney access prior to interview, cash for recruitment

<u>Jackie Brunson, Skagit County Treasurer</u> presented the Treasurers' legislative priorities. Dicussed updating registered warrants. Does not comply with current banking standards.

Vice-President Gadman **MOVED** to recommend the proposals to the membership. Past-President Pettit **SECONDED**. The **MOTION CARRIED** unanimously.

## a. Final Version of WACO 2023-2027 Strategic Plan

<u>Jennifer Wallace, Executive Director</u> introduced <u>Brian Murphy and Kizz Prusia of Berk Consulting</u>. Brian Murphy and Kizz Prusia presented the final draft 2023-2027 Strategic Plan. The Board discussed the draft content for further conversation and review by the Strategic Plan Committee.

Trustee at Large Gordon **MOVED** to approve the Strategic Plan as presented. Trustee at Large Henderson **SECONDED**. The **MOTION CARRIED** unanimously.

#### b. Updates to the WACO Policy Manual

<u>Jennifer Wallace, Executive Director</u> presented changes to the WACO Policy Manual. The changes update the Committees policy to add a Newly Elected Officials Training committee. Additionally, suggested changes to the Annual Report policy include an update on publications timelines allowing an earlier issuance of the report.

Past-President Pettit **MOVED** to approve the Policy Manual changes with an amendment to include language stating the Education Committee Chair shall be Chair of the Newly Elected Officials Training committee. Vice-President Gadman **SECONDED**. The **MOTION CARRIED** unanimously.

Executive Director Wallace Present the Nominating Committee report discussing the slate of nominees for the 2022 WACO Board of Trustees election and an overview of the election process.

### 5) Other Business

### a. Affiliate Updates

<u>Mike Lonergan, Assessors' Trustee</u> provided the Assessors' update. Discussed public education efforts on average valuation increases. Discussed market cooling in 2022 and potential effects on residential valuation. Discussed the progress of the aerial imaging study conducted by the Department of Commerce. Discussed assessor/treasurer software upgrade needs.

Trustee Henley provided the Auditors' update. Discussed Auditors dealing with attacks on elections and voting integrity by utilizing the public records process.

<u>Melissa Beaton, Clerks' Trustee</u> provided the Clerks' update. Discussed issues regarding identification of juvenile records through initials only implementation issues, civil protection order sealing issues, as well as a Blake refund bureau update.

Trustee Tunheim presented the Prosecutors' update. Biggest issue facing the Prosecutors are workload and recruitment and retention. Prosecutors have communication issues to work on in that regard. Discussed Blake response and addressing simple possession issues including impacts on juveniles.

Trustee Valz and Vice-President Gadman presented the Treasurers' update. Discussed ongoing recruitment and retention issues. Provided a cost recovery workgroup update.

## b. Trustee at Large Updates

<u>Linda Hjelle, Trustee at Large Position 2</u> presented the Trustee group 2 update. Discussed the different needs of counties based on size. Discussed work on the monthly packed lunch breakout sessions.

<u>Brenda Chilton, Trustee at Large Position 3</u> presented the Trustee group 3 update. Discussed wage compression, supply chain issues impacting counties, public health, and an increase in low level crime.

<u>Lisa Frazier, Trustee at Large Position 4</u> presented the Trustee group 4 update. Discussed staffing issues and the benefits of the packed lunch series.

Trustee at Large Gordon presented the Trustee group 5 update. Discussed federal covid response funds issues.

Trustee at Large Henderson presented the Trustee group 6 update. Discussed housing issues, recruitment, a lack of public information officers and training needed to fill the void, the cost of risk pool insurance, and the impact of public records requests on staffing and budget.
